SUBJECT: AGREEMENT BETWEEN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY AND THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF WATER FACILITIES TO SERVICE THE BROWNSVILLE MIDDLE SCHOOL SITE (STATE SCHOOL "FF-1")

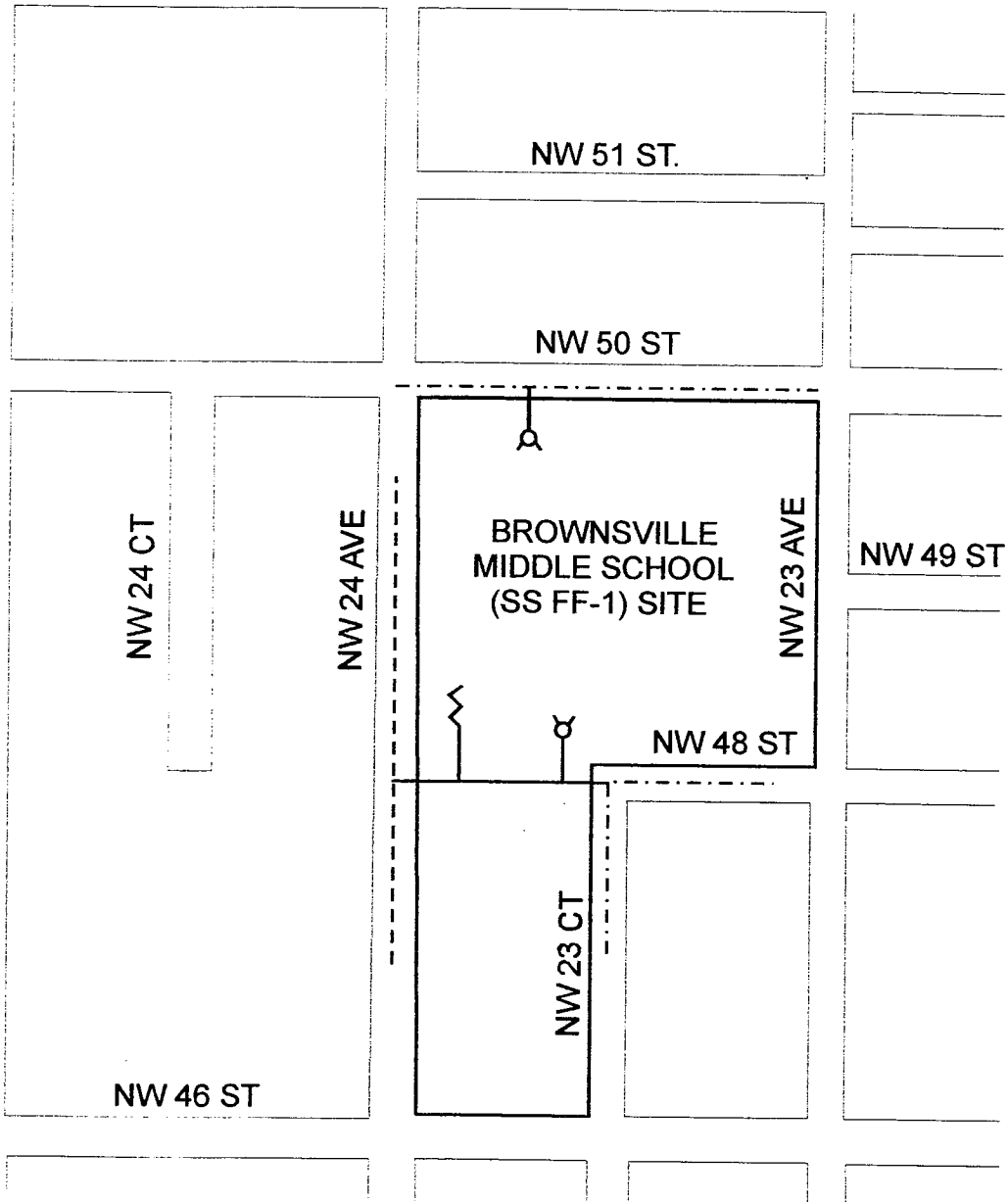
In order to provide potable water, irrigation, and additional fire protection to the Brownsville Middle School site, the Board must install and connect a water main, two fire hydrants and other appurtenances to the existing Miami-Dade County (County) infrastructure (see location map).

The 9-acre school site is located at 4899 NW 24 Avenue. A proposed 8" water main will connect to an existing County-owned 8" water main located at NW 24 Avenue and then extend east on School Board property to connect to a 6" County-owned water main located on NW 23 Court and NW 48 Street. The approximate cost for the installation of these water facilities is \$20,225.

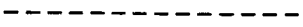
The agreement for the water facility installation has been reviewed and recommended by the Office of Capital Improvement Projects and the School Board Attorney's Office. Public utility facilities constructed on Board-owned property will be conveyed, with appropriate easements, to Miami-Dade County for future maintenance and operation.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent or his designee to execute an agreement with Miami-Dade County and include the execution of relevant conveyance documents for the provision of water services for planned improvements at the Brownsville Middle (State School "FF-1") School site, at an approximate cost of \$20,225 which is included in the construction contract.

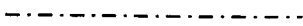
LOCATION MAP
