**SUBJECT: SUSPENSION OF EMPLOYEE  
DIANNAH M. ROBBINS - SCHOOL BUS DRIVER  
SOUTH TRANSPORTATION CENTER**

On November 28, 2001, the Superintendent of Schools sent the following letter to Ms. Diannah M. Robbins:

I am exercising my responsibility as Superintendent of Schools and recommending to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, at its scheduled meeting of December 12, 2001, that the School Board suspend you without pay from your current position as School Bus Driver, at South Transportation Center, for 30 calendar days, effective at the close of the workday, December 12, 2001, for just cause, including, but not limited to: non-performance and deficient performance of job responsibilities; violation of School Board Rules 6Gx13-3E-1.10, Transportation-Specific Procedures; and 6Gx13-4A-1.21, Responsibilities and Duties. This action is taken in accordance with Sections 230.03(2), 230.23(5)(f), and 447.209, Florida Statutes; and Article XI, Sections 4B and C of the **Contract between the Miami-Dade County Public Schools and the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees**.

You have waived, in writing, your right to contest your suspension.

**RECOMMENDED:** That effective December 12, 2001, at the close of the workday, the School Board suspend Ms. Diannah M. Robbins, School Bus Driver, at South Transportation Center, for 30 calendar days without pay.
