SUBJECT: REJECT REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS NO. 181-AA10 – CONSULTING SERVICES FOR EVALUATION, DESIGN AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE DISTRICT'S DEPARTMENT OF FOOD AND NUTRITION AS IT RELATES TO THE CLOSING OF HIGH SCHOOL CAMPUSES

The purpose of this Request For Proposals, opened on May 3, 2001, was to establish a contract, to perform specific consulting services to the Department of Food and Nutrition, relating to the closing of high school campuses, during the school lunch period. Of 15 proposers sent proposal forms or card notices of this advertised proposal, 6 responded, with 6 proposals meeting specifications.

Subsequent to the evaluation committee's action to recommend the award of this proposal, it has been determined that based on the current financial constraints at both the state and local levels and the need to evaluate the overall food service operation, it would be in the best interest of the District to reject all proposals submitted.
