**SUBJECT: REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF 2001 - 2002 EDUCATIONAL EXCELLENCE
SCHOOL ADVISORY COUNCIL MEMBERSHIP ROSTERS**

Every Miami-Dade County public school and educational center has created an Educational Excellence School Advisory Council. They are composed of the school principal and an appropriately balanced number of teachers, educational support employees, students, parents, and other business and community people who are representative of the ethnic, racial, linguistic, disabled, and economic community served by the school. The rosters are updated annually to fill vacancies. All concerns about composition and requests for composition waivers have been reviewed by the Family and Community Involvement Advisory Committee, a subcommittee of the Educational Excellence School Advisory Council.

A copy of the Educational Excellence School Advisory Council Membership Rosters will be provided to School Board Members under separate cover and will be available for inspection by the public in the office of Board Recording Secretary and the Citizen Information Center.
