SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR SCHOOL BOARD APPROVAL OF THE CHARTER

SCHOOL CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT FOR KEYS GATE CHARTER

SCHOOL

The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, approved the charter school application for Keys Gate Charter School on December 13, 2000, and authorized the Superintendent to negotiate the charter school contractual agreement with the applicant for a term of ten (10) years commencing with the 2002-2003 school year. The Charter School Contract Review Committee met on February 7, 2002, and by a majority vote, made a recommendation for approval of the charter school contractual agreement.

Keys Gate Charter School will be located at SW 152 Avenue and SE 24 Street, Homestead, Florida (an assigned address will be provided by the Post Office). The governing board will operate the school through a management contract with Charter Schools USA, Jonathan K. Hage, President and CEO. The charter school will serve a maximum of 900 students enrolled in grades Kindergarten through 8, with 800 students enrolled in grades Kindergarten through 7 in its first year of operation.

The following is the initial Board of Directors for Keys Gate Charter School: Mr. Jonathan K. Hage, Charter Schools USA; Mr. Joaquin Aviñó, Wolfberg Alvarez Group; and Mr. Edward J. Pozzuoli, Tripp Scott.

Keys Gate Charter School will be open to any student residing in Miami-Dade County. District schools in close proximity to the charter school include:

Section 228.056, Florida Statutes, Charter Schools, requires that the major issues involved in the operation of charter schools be considered in advance and written into a charter school contractual agreement between the charter school and the Sponsor, following a public hearing to ensure community input.

2003 school year.
