The purpose of this request is to obtain prior approval of supplemental awards on the following term bids, inasmuch as the estimated requirements, previously awarded by the Board, will be exceeded before the bid terms expire.

Bid No. 181-XX03 - SMOKED SAUSAGE, A LA CARTE (REBID), to establish a contract, to purchase, at firm unit prices, quantities, as may be required, of smoked sausage, for the a la carte program of the Food Service Program, for the Department of Food and Nutrition, during the term of the bid, effective June 21, 2001, through June 20, 2002. This supplemental award is requested due to increased usage, as a result of the closed campus initiative. Last contract usage averaged \$3,645.61 per month, while this year's usage has averaged \$5,362.50 per month. The supplemental amount requested is based on the average monthly expenditure, times the twelve (12) month contract period, minus the original award amount, plus a ten percent (10%) anticipated increase usage.

Bid No. 118-AA11 – SPEECH AND HEARING EQUIPMENT AND ACCESSORIES, CATALOG DISCOUNT, to establish a contract, to purchase, at firm percentage discounts, quantities, as may be required, of speech and hearing equipment and accessories for Exceptional Student Education and various schools, during the term of the bid, effective June 20, 2001, through June 19, 2002. This supplemental award is requested due to higher than anticipated usage, resulting from various speech and hearing devices requested for specific students and new equipment funded with federal grant funds. The monthly usage has averaged approximately \$23,808.87, however, the supplemental amount requested is based on the average monthly expenditure amount, times the twelve (12) month contract period, minus the original award amount, plus an additional \$163,951. The additional amount is requested to provide equipment for ESE students at F.D.L.R.S South, funded under a specific grant.
