SUBJECT: AMEND SCHOOL BOARD RULE 6Gx13-7E-1.02, EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES – NAMING

This item is submitted for consideration by the Board to prevent naming any school or school facility after any living Board member, regardless of whether they are currently serving on the Board or have served previously.

Board Rule 6Gx13-<u>7E-1.02</u> currently states:

- ...I. Names to be proposed shall be selected in accordance with the following guidelines:
 - A. If the school or school facility is to be named by its location in the community, the names proposed should be descriptive and of reasonable length.
 - B. If the school or school facility is to be named for a man or woman, the names proposed should be:
 - 1. Those of outstanding civic, or educational leaders, or individuals who have made a significant contribution to humanity whether living or deceased, of local, national, or international prominence.
 - 2. If the school or school facility is to be named for a living person, the eponym's consent will first be obtained....

The purposes of this agenda item is to recommend the following addition:

3. At no time should any school or school facility be named after any living Board member, regardless of whether they are currently serving on the Board or have served previously.

The Board authorizes and directs the Superintendent to initiate rule making procedures in accordance with the above recommendation.

ACTION PROPOSED BY DR. MARTA PEREZ:

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida authorize the Superintendent to amend Board Rule 6Gx13-7E-1.02, Educational Facilities — Naming, to prevent naming any school or school facility after any living Board member, regardless of whether they are currently serving on the Board or have served previously.
