SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR SCHOOL BOARD APPROVAL OF THE CHARTER SCHOOL CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH ARCHIMEDEAN ACADEMY, INC. ON BEHALF OF ARCHIMEDEAN ACADEMY

The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, approved a charter school application on February 13, 2002. The Board authorized the Superintendent to negotiate a charter school contractual agreement with the applicant for a term of ten years commencing with the 2002-2003 school year. The Charter School Contract Review Committee met on May 3, 2002, and by a majority vote made a recommendation for approval of the charter school contractual agreement with Archimedean Academy, Inc.

Archimedean Academy will be located at 10870 SW 113 Place, Miami, Florida 33176. The governing board will operate the school through a management contract with Academica Corporation, Mr. Fernando Zulueta, President. The charter school will serve a maximum of 500 students enrolled in grades kindergarten through six, with a maximum of 125 students enrolled in grades kindergarten through two in the first year of operation.

Archimedean Academy will be open to any student in grades kindergarten through six residing in Miami-Dade County. District schools in close proximity to the charter school include:
