SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH TO RECEIVE FUNDS TO INSTALL FIRE SAFETY GATES AT MIAMI BEACH SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL. PROJECT CYCLE: JUNE 19. 2002 **THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2002**

The City of Miami Beach received an entitlement grant from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development as part of its Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program. The City of Miami Beach allocated funds to purchase and install panic hardware on eight fire safety gates to satisfy safety requirements at Miami Beach Senior High School.

Authorization is being requested to enter into a contractual agreement with the City of Miami Beach to receive funds in the amount of \$15,973 for the installation of fire safety gates at Miami Beach Senior High School.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- enter into a contractual agreement with the City of Miami 1. Beach to receive funds, in the amount of \$15,973, to install fire safety gates at Miami Beach Senior High School, Project Cycle: June 19, 2002 through September 30, 2002;
- 2. extend this contractual agreement, at no additional cost, for up to one year, as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, if deemed necessary, in order to fully expend the grant award and thus complete the scope of the project; and
- 3. direct Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency: appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
