SUBJECT: NORTH DADE EXCEPTIONAL STUDENT EDUCATION CENTER PROJECT SPECIFIC FACILITIES LIST

This facility is designed to serve two groups of students with mental handicaps and will have an expected capacity of 150 exceptional education students with disabilities. The first group of approximately 60, K-12 students is dually diagnosed (mentally handicapped and with mental health needs). This program will be operated in conjunction with Metropolitan Dade County and is replacing the Specialized Development Center-North, which was relocated from a facility in Miami Lakes to a temporary location due to structural problems in the Metropolitan Dade County building. Metropolitan Dade County provides mental health services for the students and their families along with clinical supervision of the program.

The second program will service a population of approximately 90 mentally handicapped students who have aged-out of high school programs but who must, under law, be served in a K-12 program until 22 years of age. By moving students beyond high school age to this facility, space is created to move high school age students currently being served in middle schools. Such a move was a recommendation made by OPPAGA in their recent report. In an effort to make space available in high schools the students in this program will be 18-22 years of age and will be receiving educational services though community-based instruction.

It is planned that students from the first program can transition to the second as they reach 18 years of age and that there are other instructional synergies that are created when the two programs coexist.

The attached facilities list is representative of the instructional and support spaces necessary to adequately serve the program.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida approve the project specific facilities list for North Dade Exceptional Student Education Center.
