SUBJECT: PREQUALIFICATION OF CONTRACTORS FOR EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES CONSTRUCTION

On December 9, 1998, The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, adopted School Board Rule 6Gx13-7D-1.05, Prequalification of Contractors for Educational Facilities Construction. This rule was created pursuant to Section 235.31 of the Florida Statutes and State Requirements for Educational Facilities (1997), which require school districts to prequalify contractors prior to their bidding on schoolwork. This law became effective July 1, 1998.

The following contractors have submitted all required information and are being recommended for prequalification.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida,

- (1) approve the above list of contractors for prequalification and authorize staff to issue a certificate to each contractor, certifying prequalification for a period of one (1) year; and
- (a) declare City Air, Inc. SA Consultants, LLC., and Quality Communications of Florida, Inc. as not eligible for prequalification at this time and authorize the Superintendent to officially inform the contractors of such ineligibility.
