SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR APPROVAL OF THE NEW 2002-2003 DISTRICT/REGION ASSISTANCE AND INTERVENTION PLANS FOR SCHOOLS DESIGNATED AS SCHOOL PERFORMANCE GRADE "F" FOR THE FIRST TIME, AS REQUIRED BY THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION

As required by the Florida Department of Education, new 2002-2003 District/Region Assistance and Intervention Plans for schools designated as School Performance Grade "F" for the first time have been developed. These plans are designed to assist schools in improving student performance. Each plan is unique to the needs of the school and is aligned to each schools' School Performance Excellence Plan.

To facilitate the review and approval of these new 2002-2003 District/Region Assistance and Intervention Plans, copies of the plan for each school will be transmitted to School Board Members under separate cover. The plans will be available for inspection by the public in the Office of Board Recording Secretary and in the Citizen Information Center.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida:

1. approve the new 2002-2003 District/Region Assistance and Intervention Plans for schools designated as School Performance Grade "F" for the first time, as required by the Florida Department of Education; and
2. authorize the Superintendent to review and revise the plans as necessary based on site-specific data and needs.
