**SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT
AWARD FROM THE CORPORATION FOR PUBLIC
BROADCASTING FOR A RADIO COMMUNITY SERVICE GRANT
FOR WLRN-FM, PROJECT CYCLE: OCTOBER 1, 2002
THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2004**

COMMITTEE: FEDERAL PROGRAMS AND GRANTS ADMINISTRATION

In 2000, the Corporation for Public Broadcasting (CPB) provided a Radio Community Service Grant in the amount of \$241,020, to support day-to-day operations of WLRN-FM during 2000-2002. The School Board will be eligible for a continuation of the Radio Community Service Grant in the amount of \$246,119, for the 2002-04 fiscal years.

The funds provided by this grant will be used to support programming, personnel and operations of WLRN-FM. However, \$70,612, or approximately 29% of the grant, must be used to pay a portion of the costs of WLRN-FM programming that is provided by National Public Radio or Public Radio International, including programs such as Morning Edition, Talk of the Nation, Fresh Air, All Things Considered, The Tavis Smiley Show, Car Talk, Weekend Edition, Living on Earth, A Prairie Home Companion, Market Place and This American Life.

Official notification of this grant award was received on September 19, 2002. The budget period for this award allows for the reimbursement of expenditures from October 1, 2002.

No local funds are required.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. accept a grant award, from the Corporation for Public Broadcasting in the amount of \$246,119, for a Radio Community Service Grant for WLRN-FM, Project Cycle: October 1, 2002 through September 30, 2004;
2. extend this grant award, at no additional cost, for up to one year, as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, if deemed necessary, in order to fully expend the grant award and thus complete the scope of the project; and
3. direct Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
