**SUBJECT: REQUEST TO ADD A POSITION TO THE SENIOR MANAGEMENT
 SERVICE CLASS (SMSC) OF THE FLORIDA RETIREMENT SYSTEM**

COMMITTEE: PERSONNEL SERVICES, MEDIA COMMUNICATION AND MARKETING

Pursuant to Florida Statute 121.055, the Senior Management Service Class (SMSC) of the Florida Retirement System (FRS) permits inclusion of a limited number of local agency positions which must be:

- nonelective managerial or policy making positions;
- filled by employees who are not subject to continuing contracts and are serving at the pleasure of the employer without civil service protection; and
- heads of organizational units, or positions with responsibility to effect or recommend personnel, budget, expenditure, or policy decisions in their areas of responsibility.

It is recommended that the position of Chief Financial Officer Designate be included in the SMSC, effective November 1, 2002.

A notice of intent is required to be published once a week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation before designating a position to be included in the SMSC. This notice of intent has been published in *The Miami Daily Business Review* September 18 and September 25, 2002.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the inclusion of the position of Chief Financial Officer Designate in the Senior Management Service Class of the Florida Retirement System, effective November 1, 2002.
