**SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF 2002 - 2003 EDUCATIONAL EXCELLENCE  
SCHOOL ADVISORY COUNCIL MEMBERSHIP ROSTERS**

**COMMITTEE: ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION AND SCHOOL  
OPERATIONS**

In keeping with Section 229.58, Florida Statutes (new 1001.452, F.S.) and School Board Rule 6Gx13 - 1B-1.031, every Miami-Dade County public school and educational center has created an Educational Excellence School Advisory Council, (EESAC). Each Council must be composed of the school principal and an appropriately balanced number of teachers, education support employees, students, parents, and other business and community citizens who are representative of the ethnic, racial, linguistic, disabled, and economic community served by the school. A majority of its members must be persons not employed at that school. At least one member must represent the Exceptional Student Education program at the school. The rosters are updated annually to fill vacancies. All concerns regarding composition and requests for composition waivers have been reviewed by the EESAC Support Committee.

EESACs have the responsibility to assist in the preparation and evaluation of the School Performance Excellence Plan, to assist in the preparation of the school's annual budget, to make decisions about the expenditure of lottery funds designated to each one, to meet school improvement goals, and to decide jointly with the staff on the expenditure of school recognition funds.

A copy of the Educational Excellence School Advisory Council Membership Rosters will be provided to School Board Members under separate cover and will be available for inspection by the public in the Office of Board Recording Secretary and the Citizen Information Center.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, approve the 2002 - 2003 Educational Excellence School Advisory Council Membership Roster.
