**SUBJECT: EXTEND CONTRACT NO. 056-AA03 – FOOD ITEMS: FROZEN
AND REFRIGERATED**

COMMITTEE: FINANCIAL AFFAIRS

The purpose of the bid, opened on December 21, 2000, was to establish a contract, to purchase, at firm unit prices, quantities, as may be required, of frozen and refrigerated food items, for use in the Food Service Program of the Department of Food and Nutrition. The terms of agreement, as contained in the contract, awarded by the Board on February 14, 2001 (partial award), June 20, 2001 (balance award), and extended on February 13, 2002, provided, that by mutual agreement between the successful vendors and The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, the contract may be extended for two (2) additional one (1) year periods and, if needed, ninety (90) days beyond the expiration date of the current contract period. The contract is currently in its first extension period.
