**SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION NO. 03-13 OF THE
 SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA,
 DESIGNATING MARCH 2003 AS WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH TO
 BE CELEBRATED IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS**

In 1998, the Florida Legislature amended Section 233.061, Florida Statutes, to require instruction in women's contributions to the United States. Throughout each school year, students in Miami-Dade County Public Schools study the many contributions of women, which is also a requirement of the district's Pupil Progression Plan and the K-12 social studies instructional program. Additionally, each year, the Congress of the United States issues a resolution designating March as Women's History Month. A Presidential Proclamation is also issued encouraging all Americans to observe this month.

The Division of Social Sciences has developed a women's history curriculum resource guide entitled *FACES, A Journey Through Women's History*, to support this mandate. This resource guide has been distributed to all schools with training provided to school-site representatives in using the materials. Additional instructional materials in FCAT format have also been developed by the Division and disseminated to all schools. A curriculum packet to support this year's National Women's History Month Theme: "Women Pioneering the Future" will be distributed to all schools in February.

Therefore, it is fitting that the Board approve Resolution No. 03-13 of the School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, as a continuing example of leadership and with the recognition that it will create a heightened awareness and appreciation of the many significant contributions women have made to the United States.

RESOLUTION NO. 03-13 OF THE

WHEREAS, American women of every culture, class, and ethnic background have made historic contributions to the growth and strength of our Nation in countless recorded and unrecorded ways; and

WHEREAS, American women have played and continue to play a critical economic, cultural, and social role in every sphere of the life of the Nation by constituting a significant portion of the labor force working inside and outside of the home; and

WHEREAS, American women have played a unique role through the history of the Nation by providing the majority of the volunteer labor force of the Nation; and

WHEREAS, American women were particularly important in the establishment of early charitable, philanthropic, and cultural institutions in our Nation; and

WHEREAS, American women of every culture, class, and ethnic background served as early leaders in the forefront of every major progressive social change movement; and

WHEREAS, American women have been leaders, not only in securing their own rights of suffrage and equal opportunity, but also in the abolitionist movement, the emancipation movement, the industrial labor movement, the civil rights movement, and other movements, especially the peace movement, which create a more fair and just society for all; and

WHEREAS, despite these contributions, the role of American women in history has been consistently overlooked and undervalued in the literature, teaching, and study of American history; and

WHEREAS, in Miami-Dade County Public Schools, the study of the contributions of women to the United States is mandatory;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, approve Resolution No. 03-13 of The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, designating March 2003 as Women's History Month to be celebrated in all Miami-Dade County Public Schools.
