SUBJECT: PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF BOARD RULES: INITIAL READING

6Gx13- 6A-1.02, ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL CALENDAR

6Gx13- 6C-1.02, ADULT/VOCATIONAL EDUCATION SCHOOL CALENDAR

COMMITTEE: LEGISLATIVE RELATIONS, PUBLIC RELATIONS AND PERSONNEL SERVICES

This item is submitted for consideration by the School Board to amend its rules pertaining to the school calendars opening schools before Labor Day, on Monday, August 25, 2003. The attached proposed 2003-2004 school calendars for Elementary and Secondary and Adult/Vocational Education were developed by the Miami-Dade County Public Schools/United Teachers of Dade School Calendar Ad Hoc Committee. The committee was composed of teachers, principals, district administrators, and representatives from all bargaining units and Parent-Teacher Association (PTA)/Parent-Teacher-Student Association (PTSA).

The criteria below were considered in developing the calendars:

- Elementary and Secondary Schools
 - 180 days for students
 - 196 days for teachers (180 days for students, 10 teacher planning days, and six (6) legal holidays)
- Adult/Vocational Education
 - 216 days for students
 - 234 days for teachers (216 days for students; 12 teacher planning days, and six (6) legal holidays)
- Preschool and post school planning days
- Corresponding recess days where possible

Two proposed Elementary and Secondary School Calendars and two proposed Adult/Vocational Education School Calendars were presented to representatives from United Teachers of Dade (UTD); American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees (AFSCME); Confidential Exempt Employees; Dade Association of School Administrators (DASA); Dade County School Administrators Association (DCSAA); Dade

County School Maintenance Employees Committee (DCSMEC); Fraternal Order of Police (FOP); Dade County Council of Parent-Teacher Association and Parent-Teacher-Student Association (PTA/PTSA); and the Student Government Association of senior high schools for distribution to their members for review, reaction, and selection. The calendar options proposed by the School Calendar Ad Hoc Committee for the 2003-2004 school year offers two choices of beginning school dates, an opening school date before Labor Day and an opening school date after Labor Day.

The majority of individuals responding favored an opening school date before Labor Day, Monday, August 25, 2003, for both Elementary and Secondary schools and Adult/Vocational Education centers for the 2003-2004 school year. The selected calendar with a start date before Labor Day will be used as a guide to develop the Extended Year School Calendars for Charles R. Drew Elementary, North Miami Elementary, Opa-locka Elementary, Toussaint Louverture Elementary, Edison Schools, Inc.-Henry E.S. Reeves Elementary schools and the Juvenile Justice Education centers.

Attached are the Notice of Intended Action and proposed rules for amendment. Changes from the current rules are indicated by underscoring words to be added and ~~striking through~~ words to be deleted.

Authorization of the Board is requested for the Superintendent to initiate rulemaking proceedings in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act for the amendment of Board Rules 6Gx13- 6A-1.02, Elementary and Secondary School Calendar, 2002-2003, and 6Gx13- 6C-1.02, Adult/Vocational Education School Calendar, 2002-2003.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to initiate rulemaking proceedings in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act to amend Board Rules:

- 1) 6Gx13- 6A-1.02, Elementary and Secondary School Calendar, 2002-2003; and
- 2) 6Gx13- 6C-1.02, Adult/Vocational Education School Calendar, 2002-2003.

NOTICE OF INTENDED ACTION
