SUBJECT: STATUS OF FIRE SAFETY CORRECTIONS

COMMITTEE: FACILITIES MANAGEMENT

The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida is committed to ensuring a safe learning environment for its students and teachers. Many of the fire safety items in the District's schools, and cited by local Fire Marshals, have been addressed and corrected. However, a number of items are still pending, requiring correction.

Authorization is requested to direct the Superintendent of Schools to prepare a report within thirty (30) days that outlines a plan of action intended to expedite the correction of all fire safety items in the District's schools. Such a report should identify all fire safety items pending correction, in order of priority, and the criteria utilized in such prioritization. It should recommend a construction delivery method that would reduce staff involvement, and allow more time to focus on the mission of building student stations.

Finally, the report should indicate an Action Plan to complete all corrections within a period of twenty-four (24) months.
