SUBJECT: NEW PROTOTYPE FACILITIES LISTS

COMMITTEE: FACILITIES MANAGEMENT

On June 19, 2002, The School Board of Miami-Dade County approved the use of the school within a school concept and to increase the student capacity of schools. In addition, the Board directed staff to develop new facilities lists based on the larger capacities, while incorporating the school within a school concept.

The Department of Facilities Planning and Standards developed the new prototype facilities lists after review and approval from School Operations, Education, Curriculum Specialists, and appropriate technical and professional staff.

The following is a summary of the proposed lists:

- I. Primary Learning Center (280 student stations)
Elementary School (1,499 student stations)
K-8 Center (2,100 student stations)
- II. Small Middle Learning Center (515 student stations)
Large Middle Learning Center (693 student stations)
Middle School (2,094 student stations)
Middle Vocational Programs
- III. Senior High School (3,599 student stations)
Senior High Vocational Programs
- IV. Full Service (as needed)
- V. Ancillary (i.e. central administration, maint., transp., etc.)

These lists will be transmitted to the Board under separate cover and will be placed on file in the Citizen Information Center, the Office of the Board Recording Secretary and the School Board Members office, prior to the Board meeting of March 12, 2003.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida approve and adopt the proposed prototype facilities lists to be utilized for future facilities.
