SUBJECT: EXTEND CONTRACT NO. 072-BB10 – PHYSICAL EXAMINATIONS – BUS DRIVERS, NORTH OF FLAGLER STREET

COMMITTEE: BUSINESS AND FINANCIAL SERVICES

The purpose of the bid, opened on February 19, 2002, was to establish a contract, to purchase, at a firm unit price, physical examinations of bus drivers, north of Flagler Street, for the Department of Transportation. The terms of agreement, as contained in the contract, awarded by the Board on March 13, 2002, provided, that by mutual agreement between the successful vendor and The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, the contract may be extended for two (2) additional one (1) year periods. The contract is currently in its initial year. The awardee has agreed to extend for the first one (1) year extension period, by letter, on file. It is considered to be in the best interest of the Board to extend this contract, for an additional one (1) year period, at the current prices, to benefit from fixed prices during the next twelve (12) months, inasmuch as the Consumer Price Index (CPI), for medical care services, as of January 2003, indicated an increase of 4.6%.
