Assignments of personnel and appointments of professional, and technical staff are a direct result of the Board-approved advertisement and selection process.

Mr. Tahir Chaudhary is recommended for appointment to the open, budgeted position of Coordinator III, Systems and Programs, pay grade 42, Office of Educational Planning and Quality Enhancement. Mr. Chaudhary received a Bachelor of Science in Computer Science from Florida International University (FIU), Miami, Florida on December 7, 2001. From December 1997 through December 1998, he was a Data Entry Operator with Corestaff Services, Miami, Florida. From May 2001 through October 2002, Mr. Chaudhary was a Java Developer with High Performance Database Research Center at FIU. Presently, Mr. Chaudhary is a GIS Intern with the Miami Dade Fire Rescue, Office of Emergency Management, and a part-time Graduate Assistant, with FIU, College of Education.

Mr. Richard Lendor is recommended for appointment to the open, budgeted position of Coordinator I, Design and Construction Management, pay grade 40, Capital Improvement Projects. 2. **Mr. Richard Lendor** to the open, budgeted position of Coordinator I, Design and Construction Management, pay grade 40, Capital Improvement Projects, effective May 15, 2003, or as soon thereafter as can be facilitated.

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
