**SUBJECT: DISMISSAL OF EMPLOYEE
MYRON JOHNSON – SECURITY MONITOR
JOHN F. KENNEDY MIDDLE SCHOOL**

On November 4, 2003, the Superintendent of Schools sent the following letter to Mr. Myron Johnson:

I am exercising my responsibility as Superintendent of Schools and recommending to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, at its scheduled meeting of November 19, 2003, that the School Board suspend you and initiate dismissal proceedings against you from your current position as Security Monitor, at John F. Kennedy Middle School, effective at the close of the workday, November 19, 2003, for just cause, including, but not limited to: violation of School Board Rule 6Gx13- 4-1.09, Employee-Student Relationships. This action is taken in accordance with Sections 1001.32(2), 1012.22(1)(f), 1012.40 and 447.209, Florida Statutes.

If you wish to contest your suspension and dismissal, you must request a hearing in writing within 20 calendar days of the receipt of notice of the Board action, in which case, formal charges will be filed and a hearing will be held before an administrative law judge.

RECOMMENDED: That effective November 19, 2003, at the close of the workday, the School Board suspend and initiate dismissal proceedings against Myron Johnson, Security Monitor, at John F. Kennedy Middle School, pending the outcome of a hearing, if requested.
