Three years later, he moved to Miami and on the 4th of July 1953, became the founding Editor and Editorial Writer of Diario Las Américas, Miami's original Spanish language daily newspaper. Dr. Aguirre is currently the Director of Diario Las Américas which has been continuously published for the past 50 years.

During this time period, Dr. Aguirre has held a number of civic and public service positions, to mention a few, Committee President of International Affairs, Vice-President of Free Press and Information Committee, member of the World Press Freedom Committee, World Association of Newspapers and Academia Norteamericana de la Lengua Española. Additionally, he has received numerous awards such as, "Orden del Mérito", "Hombre del Año", "Orden de Isabel la Católica", Doctor Honoris Causa en Periodismo, Gran Cruz del Mérito Civil de España, issued by King Juan Carlos I of Spain, Nova Southeastern University Hispanic Advisory Board Honoree, The Spanish-American League Against Discrimination (S.A.L.A.D.) Award and countless other recognitions from prestigious organizations, universities and Hispanic governments too numerous to enumerate.

For this, and his indefatigable fight for the freedom of the press, minority rights, and justice, and his life-long contributions to our world community, it is appropriate that this School Board recognize Dr. Horacio Aguirre with a proclamation in his honor.
