Six Design-Build contractors responded to the Request for Qualifications and five were selected for invitation to bid on the design criteria. The construction budget is \$1,108,000. The Design Criteria Professional's cost estimate is \$1,287,805.

This project includes minority business enterprise subcontracting assistance levels.

Advertised bids received and opened on January 6, 2004 by The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, have been tabulated and analyzed as follows:

## Description

This project is for a total window and partial door replacement for the existing facility. This excludes the remodeled administration area and the new media center.

The Design Criteria Professional (DCP), Reynolds, Smith & Hills, Inc. and District staff recommended rejection of the contract because one firm which had been originally selected was inadvertently, not notified by the DCP of the rebid. This oversight will become part of their evaluation.

This project was bid with M.B.E. subcontracting assistance levels of 18% African-American and 6% Women. The recommended contractor will submit M/WBE subcontractors as participants in this project which will be reviewed and monitored for compliance with overall M/WBE assistance levels of 24%.
