**SUBJECT: AWARD REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS NO. 045-DD10 – FLEET
 MAINTENANCE SOFTWARE (REBID)**

COMMITTEE: BUSINESS AND FINANCIAL SERVICES

The purpose of this Request For Proposals, opened on November 20, 2003, is to establish a contract, at a firm price, to provide fleet maintenance software, for the Department of Transportation/Vehicle Maintenance. Of 26 proposers sent proposal forms or card notices of this advertised proposal, 12 responded, with 9 proposals meeting specifications and 3 no proposals.

This proposed contract addresses several recommendations presented by OPAGGA, the Oversight Board, and Management and Compliance Audits. The software will increase the efficiency of fleet maintenance operations, resulting in a projected savings to the District of nearly \$2 million over a five-year period. This project has identified funding and has been approved and prioritized by the Information Technology Steering Committee.
