SUBJECT: AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF HIALEAH AND THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF WATER FACILITIES TO SERVICE THE HIALEAH-MIAMI LAKES SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL SITE PORTABLE CLASSROOM REPLACEMENT PROJECT A0825S7131

COMMITTEE: FACILITIES MANAGEMENT

In order to provide additional fire protection to the Hialeah - Miami Lakes Senior High School site, (Portable Replacement Project), the Board must install and connect a water main extension and fire hydrants and other appurtenances to the existing City of Hialeah (City) infrastructure (see location map).

The 36-acre school site is located at 7977 W 12 Avenue. A proposed 8 inch water main will interconnect to an existing City-owned 16 inch water main at W 12 Avenue. Two new hydrants will be installed. The approximate cost for the installation of these water facilities is \$31,000.

The agreement for the water facilities installation has been reviewed and recommended by the Office of Capital Improvement Projects and the School Board Attorney's Office. Public utility facilities constructed on Board-owned property will be conveyed, with appropriate easements, to the City of Hialeah for future maintenance and operation.
