The Corporation for National and Community Service, Learn & Serve America School-Based Programs awards grants to the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) to support Community/Higher Education/School Partnership (CHESP) programs. The purpose of this grant is to engage kindergarten through post-secondary students in models of collaborative service-learning activities that link to the application of academic learning to improve student performance, to enhance civic engagement, and to provide opportunities for career exploration.

In 2000, the Bureau of Community and Hospitality Services of the Miami-Dade County Public Schools was awarded a CHESP grant to implement an Intergenerational Community Studies Oral History Program. The program involved teams of Miami-Dade County students and teachers, in collaboration with University of Miami students and professors, in an innovative oral history program. The program captures the memories of historical events of local community elders through an interviewing and videotaping process.

Authorization is requested to accept a grant award which will support the district's CHESP Program. Grant funds in the amount of \$36,500 will be used for professional development of teachers, substitute teacher coverage, student transportation, out-of-county travel, supplies, and printing. The required in-kind match valued at \$36,500 is covered by personnel, professional development, and substitute funds.

Official notification of this grant award was received on March 15, 2004, which is after the start of the grant period. Reimbursement of grant-related expenditures is authorized effective February 4, 2004.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- 1. accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education for funding the Community/Higher Education/School Partnership (CHESP) Program in the amount of \$36,500 for the grant period of February 4, 2004 through December 31, 2004;
- extend this program as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, in order to complete the goals of the program; and
- 3. direct Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
