SUBJECT: AUTHORIZE THE SUPERINTENDENT TO REVIEW THE

FEASIBILITY OF A CURRICULUM-BASED PROTOTYPICAL FACILITY FOR IMPLEMENTATION IN K-8 CONVERSION

Recently, there has been renewed interest in K-8 conversions at a number of existing elementary schools. Presently, these conversions are done on a case-by-case basis through the addition of a Middle Learning Center (MLC) and generally include not only general purpose classrooms and a cafeteria, but also other spaces such as art and music labs, vocational labs, administrative space and a P.E. multi-purpose room. In order to better prepare the School Board for future discussions on this topic, particularly as to cost and time implications, I am requesting that the Superintendent review the feasibility of a curriculum-based prototypical MLC facility for possible implementation in future K-8 conversions. This MLC would encompass only basic required spaces such as general purpose classrooms, cafeteria and bathroom facilities but not the more elaborate spaces referenced above.

ACTION PROPOSED BY AGUSTIN J. BARRERA:

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to review the feasibility of a curriculum-based prototypical facility for implementation in K-8 conversions, as more specifically detailed above.
