SUBJECT: REQUEST AUTHORIZATION FOR THE SUPERINTENDENT TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, DIVISION OF CHILD DEVELOPMENT SERVICES, FOR FUNDING AFTER-SCHOOL CARE SERVICES

COMMITTEE: EDUCATION AND SCHOOL OPERATIONS

Miami-Dade County, Division of Child Development Services, solicited responses to a Request For Proposals (RFP) from public and private agencies for the purchase of after-school care services during the period of July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005. Miami-Dade County Public Schools developed a proposal to expand after-school care services at eligible schools in accordance with the specifications of the RFP. The district has participated in subsidized child care programs since 1989.

Authorization is requested to enter into a contractual agreement with Miami-Dade County, Division of Child Development Services, to provide subsidized child care services. This agreement serves children referred to existing programs by Miami-Dade County, Division of Child Development Services, and is established as an open contract. Neither the number of children to be served nor the amount of funds per center is stated in the contract.

The daily program includes educational, recreational, social, and cultural activities. A supervised homework time is provided, as well as a snack. Parents are encouraged to participate in the activities of the program.

The funding requested for each center is based upon the number of children served for the 260 days the centers are in operation. Funds received for the after-school care program will provide part-time salaries, food service, supplies, and equipment. Reimbursement is computed at \$6 per child per day for the days students are in school. Appropriations from Miami-Dade County to each center are ultimately adjusted to reflect actual revenues generated by that center.

Mr. Donald Manning is the Assistant Director for Miami-Dade County Department of Human Services.

There are no costs associated with this program since related expenses will be reimbursed by Miami-Dade County, Division of Child Development Services.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. enter into a contractual agreement with Miami-Dade County, Division of Child Development Services, for funding after school care services, effective July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005; and
2. receive reimbursements not to exceed \$6 per child per diem, for the services rendered.
