**SUBJECT: REQUEST AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD
THROUGH A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH BARRY
UNIVERSITY FOR THE WILLIAM F. GOODLING EVEN START
FAMILY LITERACY GRANT PROGRAM AT SOUTH DADE
MIGRANT CAMP**

COMMITTEE: EDUCATION AND SCHOOL OPERATIONS

Barry University has received a grant from the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) to implement the William F. Goodling Even Start Family Literacy Grant (Even Start) at the South Dade Migrant Camp. Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) is collaborating with Barry University to implement the Even Start program at the South Dade Migrant Camp which is a federally-funded program designed to enhance the educational opportunities of the nation's adults and pre-school children. The principal focus of the program is to help parents become full partners in the educational process of their children.

Grant program activities include parent training, adult education for parents, and early education and care for children from birth to four years of age. The grant program will further provide medical and social screenings, referrals, and home-based visitations. Family support services will be provided utilizing strategies which reflect the various cultures of the participating families.

Barry University will contract with M-DCPS to provide the early childhood component of the grant through the Division of Early Childhood Programs. The Executive Director of the Office of Migrant Education and Special Projects at Barry University is the Project Director.

No matching funds are required as a condition to receive this grant funding. Grant funds will be used to cover the cost of personnel in the amount of \$269,971, for the grant period of August 19, 2004 through June 30, 2005. The grant program is renewable annually for five years based on the availability of funds.

Official notification of this grant was received on June 29, 2004.

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RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. accept a grant award through a contractual agreement with Barry University for the William F. Goodling Even Start Family Literacy Grant Program at South Dade Migrant Camp in the amount of \$269,971 for the grant period of August 19, 2004 through June 30, 2005;
2. extend this program and contractual agreement as authorized through official notification from the granting agency, in order to complete the goals of the program; and
3. direct Financial Affairs to establish appropriations in the amounts approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
