REQUEST AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (FLDOE) UNDER THE LEARN AND SERVE AMERICA SCHOOL-BASED

The Corporation for National and Community Service, Learn and Serve America School-Based Program, awards grants to the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) to initiate and sustain service-learning in schools as a strategy to improve student performance. Such service-learning programs must apply the Sunshine State Standards, address community needs, and provide for student civic engagement and career exploration.

Authorization is requested to accept a grant award from the FLDOE, in the amount of \$47,250, to fund the District Infrastructure-Building Project for the grant period of September 1, 2004 through August 31, 2005.

Since 2002, the Miami-Dade County Public Schools has been the only urban school district to receive one of the three statewide District Infrastructure-Building Project Grants. The 2004-2005 school year marks the third year of successful implementation, and the project will continue efforts to expand, improve, and institutionalize service-learning in the district.

Miami-Dade County Public Schools, Bureau of Community and Hospitality Services will oversee the grant's implementation. The District Infrastructure-Building Project will:

- provide districtwide training for new school-based learn and serve programs;
- assist new school sites with implementation;
- strengthen existing district and school-based learn and serve programs;
- support the goals of the District Service-Learning Advisory Committee; and
- continue to support the district's intergenerational service-learning youth council, Generation US Council.

An in-kind match is required to receive these funds. The match requirement, valued at \$47,250, is met by personnel, professional development, student transportation, and substitute coverage provided through other district funds. Grant funds in the amount of \$47,250 will be used for professional and technical services, substitute teacher coverage, part-time hourly salaries, out-of-county travel, supplies, and printing. Indirect cost is not allowed.

Official notification of this grant award was received on July 23, 2004. Reimbursement of grant-related expenditures is authorized effective September 1, 2004.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) under the Learn and Serve America School-Based Program in the amount of \$47,250 for a grant period of September 1, 2004 through August 31, 2005;
- 2. extend this program as authorized through official notification from the granting agency in order to complete the goals of the program; and
- 3. direct Financial Operations to establish appropriations in the amounts approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
