(HAITIAN WOMEN OF MIAMI); AND MIAMI DADE COLLEGE

**EDUCATION AND SCHOOL OPERATIONS** 

Under the Adult Education and Family Literacy Act, the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) makes available Adult Education English Literacy and Civics Education Continuation grants to all eligible educational agencies through a performance-based, non-competitive grant application process. The focus is to support projects that demonstrate effective practices in providing and increasing access for adults to English literacy programs that are linked to civics education.

Authorization is requested to accept a grant from the FLDOE, in the amount of \$982,374, to fund the Adult Education English Literacy and Civics Education Continuation program for the grant period of July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005. This is the second year of this grant award.

Under this initiative, the FLDOE requires the district to form a consortium with community partners and provide a variety of services to meet the special needs of adults. M-DCPS, in collaboration with ASPIRA of Florida, Inc.; Coalition of Florida Farmworkers Organization, Inc.; Fanm Ayisyen Nan Miyami, Inc. (Haitian Women of Miami); and Miami Dade College will support programs to increase English literacy and provide civics education to ESOL adult learner clients.

In accordance with the terms of the grant application, authorization is requested to enter into separate contractual agreements with the following community-based organizations:

No matching funds are required as a condition to receive the grant funding. Funds in the amount of \$889,441 will be used for one Curriculum Support Specialist position, contracted services, part-time personnel, equipment, materials, supplies, and professional development. Indirect cost is \$37,933 for a total allocation of \$982,374.

Official notification of this grant award was received on August 9, 2004, which was after the start of the budget period. Reimbursement of grant-related expenditures is authorized effective July 1, 2004.

**RECOMMENDED:** That the School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) for funding under the Adult Education English Literacy and Civics Education Continuation Program in the amount of \$982,374 for the grant period of July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005;
- 2. enter into separate contractual agreements in the total amount of \$55,000 for the grant period of July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005 with:
  - a. ASPIRA of Florida, Inc., in the amount of \$15,000;
  - b. Coalition of Florida Farmworkers Organization, Inc., in the amount of \$5,000;
  - c. Fanm Ayisyen Nan Miyami, Inc., (Haitian Women of Miami) in the amount of \$ 10,000;
  - d. Miami Dade College, in the amount of \$25,000.
- 3. extend this program and contractual agreements as authorized through official notification from the granting agency in order to complete the goals of the program; and
- 4. direct Financial Operations to establish appropriations in the amounts approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
