SUBJECT: REQUEST THAT THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, DIRECT THE SUPERINTENDENT TO SUPPORT SENATE RESOLUTION S.RES.170 IS DESIGNATING THE YEARS 2004 AND 2005 AS YEARS OF FOREIGN LANGUAGE STUDY

COMMITTEE: LEGISLATIVE RELATIONS, PUBLIC RELATIONS AND PERSONNEL SERVICES

Senate Resolution S.RES. 170 IS designates the years 2004 and 2005 as Years of Foreign Language Study in recognition of the contributions that foreign language study makes to student cognitive development, the national economy, and national security. Communities across America are encouraged to promote and expand the studies of foreign languages and observe the Years of Foreign Language Study with appropriate ceremonies, programs, and other activities. A press conference will be held in December at the National Press Club in Washington, D.C. with public statements of support from the President of the United States, and the Secretaries of State, Education, Commerce, and Defense.

The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, is a proponent and has unanimously supported multilingual education. With this item, the Miami-Dade County School Board seeks to reaffirm its commitment to the study of world languages beginning in the early grades to enable students to develop the levels of proficiency needed to communicate effectively with persons from other cultures, whether at home or abroad. Schools are encouraged to participate in the national and local events that will promote 2004 and 2005 as the *Years of Foreign Language Study* initiative.

ACTION PROPOSED BY

MS. PERLA TABARES HANTMAN: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, direct the Superintendent to:

1. work with local government and the business community to create a proclamation in support of 2004 and 2005 as the *Years of Foreign Language Study*; and
2. encourage all schools to implement activities in support of the study of world languages.
