SUBJECT: REQUEST AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT TWO GRANT AWARDS FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (FLDOE) FOR FUNDING UNDER THE FLORIDA LEARN AND SERVE AMERICA SCHOOL-BASED PROGRAM AT MIAMI SPRINGS MIDDLE SCHOOL AND BOOKER T. WASHINGTON SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL

COMMITTEE: EDUCATION AND SCHOOL OPERATIONS

The Corporation for National and Community Service, Learn and Serve America School-Based Program awards grants to the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) for eligible agencies through a competitive grant application process. All eligible schools were notified of this grant opportunity. The goal is to improve student performance, provide for civic engagement and career exploration, and address key needs in the areas of reading, civics/history, drug/violence prevention, intergenerational interaction, and the environment.

Authorization is requested to accept two grant awards from the FLDOE in the total amount of \$13,179 to fund the Florida Learn and Serve America School-Based Program for the grant period of September 1, 2004 through August 31, 2005. This is the first year of these awards.

The following schools have received funds to implement service-learning activities under this grant initiative:

TOTAL	\$13,179

An in-kind match is required to receive these funds. The match requirement, valued at \$13,179, is met by personnel, professional development, and capital outlay provided through district funds. Grant funds in the amount of \$13,179 will be used for part-time hourly personnel, professional and technical services, travel, printing and duplicating, and supplies. Indirect cost is not allowed.

Official notification of this grant award was received on September 1, 2004. Reimbursement of grant-related expenditures is authorized effective September 1, 2004.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

1. accept two grant awards from the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) for funding under the Florida Learn and Serve America School-Based Program in the amount of \$13,179 for the grant period of September 1, 2004 through August 31, 2005 at the following schools:
 - a. Miami Springs Middle School in the amount of \$8,451; and
 - b. Booker T. Washington Senior High School in the amount of \$4,728;
2. extend these programs as authorized through official notification from the granting agency in order to complete the goals of the programs; and
3. direct Financial Operations to establish appropriations in the amounts approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.

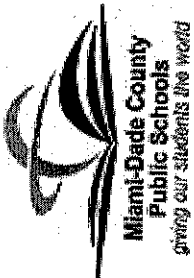
