REQUEST SCHOOL BOARD APPROVAL OF THE CHARTER SCHOOL APPLICATION FOR MOSAIC BILINGUAL ACADEMY, INC., ON BEHALF OF MOSAIC BILINGUAL ACADEMY AND AUTHORIZATION TO NEGOTIATE A CHARTER SCHOOL CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT FOR A TERM OF FIVE YEARS

As established in School Board Rule 6Gx13- 6A-1.47, Charter Schools (K-12), Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) received charter school applications from individuals and/or organizations in the community.

On October 13, 2004, M-DCPS Charter School District Review Committee met to review the application for Mosaic Bilingual Academy and by a unanimous vote made a recommendation for approval of the application to the Superintendent of Schools.

The charter school proposes to serve a maximum of 365 students in grades kindergarten through five, with a maximum of 90 students in grades kindergarten through two in its first year of operation, commencing with the 2005-2006 school year, at a facility located at 15800 NW 42 Avenue, Miami, Florida 33054.

The following is the Founding Board for the charter school: Mr. Chima A. Burey, Financial Consultant; Mr. Brian E. Clarke, Educator; Dr. Gwendolyn Howard-Robinson, Educator; Mr. Milton Vickers, Developer; Mr. William Johnson, Management Consultant; and Dr. Melina E. Castillo, Educational Administrator.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida:

- 1. approve the application for Mosaic Bilingual Academy, Inc., on behalf of Mosaic Bilingual Academy; and
- 2. authorize the Superintendent to negotiate a charter school contractual agreement for a term of five years, commencing with the 2005-2006 school year through the conclusion of the 2009-2010 school year, which reflects the contents of the application as approved by the School Board.
