REQUEST AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARD FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (FLDOE) FOR FUNDING UNDER THE IDEA, PART B, SPECIAL

PROGRAM: FLORIDA INCLUSION NETWORK (FIN)

During the 1992-1993 school year, the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE), Bureau of Instructional Support and Community Services, initiated the development of Florida's Exceptional Student Education Strategic Plan. Within the Plan, the Florida Inclusion Network (FIN) was established.

Florida Inclusion Network coordinates activities of regional facilitators, assists with the implementation of effective instructional practices, coordinates statewide training, provides assistance for on-going implementation of the revised Exceptional Student Education/Florida Education Finance Program funding model, and maintains records of the status of inclusion within the district. Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS), Office of Exceptional Student Education and Student/Career Services, supports the national trend of inclusion of exceptional students and is committed to providing training and technical support services to implement inclusion models in M-DCPS.

Authorization is requested to accept a grant award from the FLDOE in the amount of \$250,000 to fund the FIN program for the grant period of October 1, 2004 through August 31, 2005. This program has been in effect since 1999.

No matching funds are required as a condition to receive the grant funding. Grant funds in the amount of \$238,348 will fund salaries and fringe benefits for a curriculum support specialist, a secretary, contracted services, printing, supplies, equipment, software, and travel expenses. Indirect cost is \$11,652, for a total allocation of \$250,000.

Official notification of this grant award was received on September 30, 2004, which is after the start of the grant period. Reimbursement of grant-related expenditures is authorized effective October 1, 2004.

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- accept a grant award from the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) for funding under the IDEA, Part B, Special Program: Florida Inclusion Network (FIN) in the amount of \$250,000 for the grant period of October 1, 2004 through August 31, 2005;
- 2. extend this program as authorized through official notification from the granting agency in order to complete the goals of the program; and
- 3. direct Financial Operations to establish appropriations in the amounts approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
