REQUEST AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT TWO GRANT AWARDS FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (FLDOE) FOR FUNDING UNDER THE PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL FEDERAL GRANT PROGRAM AND ENTER INTO SEPARATE CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENTS WITH INTERNATIONAL STUDIES CHARTER HIGH SCHOOL, INC. AND MIAMI CHILDREN'S MUSEUM CHARTER SCHOOL, INC.

EDUCATION AND SCHOOL OPERATIONS

The Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) issued a Request for Proposals under the Public Charter School Federal Grant Program for the purpose of awarding grants to charter schools partnering with local educational agencies in order to provide a high quality education for all students. The Public Charter School Federal Grant Program provides funds only to those charter schools which have been approved by the local school district and which have established a collaborative partnership for the oversight and operation of the charter schools. Funds received from this grant will be used to improve the quality of education, support planning activities, and supplement the level of funds that would be made available from non-federal sources.

Authorization is requested to accept two grant awards, in the total amount of \$500,000, from the FLDOE and to enter into separate contractual agreements with International Studies Charter High School, Inc., in the amount of \$250,000, and Miami Children's Museum Charter School, Inc., in the amount of \$250,000, to implement their programs for the grant period of June 29, 2004 through September 30, 2005.

In collaboration with Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS), International Studies Charter High School and Miami Children's Museum Charter School submitted grant applications to support their charter school operations.

In accordance with the FLDOE grant guidelines, M-DCPS must be the fiscal agent on behalf of each of the charter schools that receive such grants. The Board's approval of the recommended action would not constitute an endorsement of the grants or its intended use. It would merely satisfy the Board's requirement under Florida Statutes, Section 1002.33, Charter Schools, which requires that M-DCPS serve as the fiscal agent.

No matching funds are required as a condition to receive the grant funding. Grant funds in the total amount of \$500,000 will be distributed as separate contractual agreements among the two schools as follows:

Official notification of these grant awards was received on September 29, 2004, which is after the start of the grant period. Reimbursement of grant-related expenditures is authorized effective June 29, 2004.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- accept two grant awards from the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) for funding under the Public Charter School Federal Grant Program in the amount of \$500,000 for the grant period of June 29, 2004 through September 30, 2005;
- 2. enter into separate contractual agreements in the total amount of \$500,000 for the grant period of June 29, 2004 through September 30, 2005:
 - a. The International Studies Charter High School, Inc., in the amount of \$238,254; and
 - b. The Miami Children's Museum Charter School, Inc., in the amount of \$238,254;
- 3. extend these programs and contractual agreements as authorized through official notification from the granting agency in order to complete the goals of the programs; and
- 4. direct Financial Operations to establish appropriations in the amounts approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
