The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, announced on October 20, 2004, its intention to amend School Board Rules 6Gx13- 6A-1.02, Elementary and Secondary School Calendar, and 6Gx13- 6C-1.02, Adult/Vocational Education School Calendar, for the 2005-2006 school year, at its meeting of December 15, 2004.

The Notice of Intended Action was published in the *Miami Daily Business Review* on October 25, 2004, posted in various places for public information, and mailed to various organizations representing persons affected by the amended rules and to individuals requesting notification.

The time to request a hearing or protest the adoption of these rules has elapsed.

In accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Procedures Act, these rules are presented to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, for adoption and authorization to file the rules in the official records of The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida.

Attached are the Notice of Intended Action and the amended rules. Changes from the current rules are indicated by underscoring words to be added and ~~striking through~~ words to be deleted.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida:

1. adopt amended Board Rule 6Gx13- 6A-1.02, Elementary and Secondary School Calendar, 2005-2006;
2. adopt amended Board Rule 6Gx13- 6C-1.02, Adult/Vocational Education School Calendar, 2005-2006; and
3. authorize the Superintendent to file the rules with The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, to be effective July 28, 2005.

THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, announced on October 20, 2004, its intention to amend Board Rules 6Gx13- 6A-1.02, Elementary and Secondary School Calendar - 2004-2005, and 6Gx13- 6C-1.02, Adult/Vocational Education School Calendar - 2004-2005, at its meeting of December 15, 2004.

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: To amend the Elementary and Secondary School Calendar and the Adult/Vocational Education School Calendar for the 2005-2006 school year.

SUMMARY: Establish school calendars for the 2005-2006 school year, designating days when students and teachers are in school beginning and ending dates for grading periods, and holidays for students and employees.

ANY PERSON WHO DECIDES TO APPEAL THE DECISION made by The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, with respect to this action will need to ensure the preparation of a verbatim record of the proceedings, including the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
