**SUBJECT: SUSPENSION OF EMPLOYEE  
ANTHONY C. BROOKS - ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL  
MIAMI JACKSON SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL**

On December 1, 2004, the Superintendent of Schools sent the following letter to Mr. Anthony C. Brooks:

I am exercising my responsibility as Superintendent of Schools and recommending to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, at its scheduled meeting of December 15, 2004, that the School Board suspend you without pay from your current position as Assistant Principal at Miami Jackson Senior High School, for 30 workdays effective at the close of the workday, December 15, 2004, for: immorality; and violation of School Board Rules 6Gx13- 4A-1.21, Responsibilities and Duties; and 6Gx13- 4-1.09, Employee-Student Relationships. This action is taken in accordance with Sections 1001.32(2), 1012.22(1)(f), 1012.33, and 447.209, Florida Statutes.

Pursuant to School Board Rule 6Gx13- 8C-1.064, Adjudicatory Proceedings, if you wish to contest your suspension, you must request a hearing in writing within 15 calendar days of the receipt of notice of the Board action, in which case, formal charges will be filed and a hearing will be held before an administrative law judge.

**RECOMMENDED:** That effective December 15, 2004, at the close of the workday, the School Board suspend Mr. Anthony C. Brooks, Assistant Principal, at Miami Jackson High School, for 30 workdays without pay, pending the outcome of a hearing, if requested.
