**SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF 2004 - 2005 EDUCATIONAL EXCELLENCE
SCHOOL ADVISORY COUNCIL MEMBERSHIP ROSTERS**

As required by Section 1001.452, F.5, Florida Statutes, every Miami-Dade County public school and educational center has created an Educational Excellence School Advisory Council (EESAC). The EESACs are composed of the principal, the United Teachers of Dade designated steward, and a balanced number of teachers, education support employees, students, parents, and business/community representatives. In addition, each ESSAC must be representative of the ethnic, racial, linguistic, disabled, and economic community served by the school, and a majority of its members must be persons not employed at that school. At least one member must represent the Exceptional Student Education program at the school. The rosters are updated annually to fill vacancies. All concerns regarding composition and requests for composition waivers are reviewed by the EESAC Support Committee.

The EESAC has the responsibility to assist in the preparation and evaluation of the School Improvement Plan, to assist in the preparation of the school's annual budget, to make decisions about the expenditure of EESAC lottery funds, to meet school improvement goals, and to decide jointly with the staff on the expenditure of school recognition funds.
