**SUBJECT: PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF BOARD RULE: INITIAL READING
6Gx13- 6A-1.023, JUVENILE JUSTICE EDUCATION EXTENDED
SCHOOL YEAR CALENDAR**

COMMITTEE: SCHOOL SUPPORT ACCOUNTABILITY

This item is submitted for consideration by the School Board to amend Board Rule 6Gx13-6A-1.023, Juvenile Justice Education Extended School Year Calendar, 2004-2005. The attached proposed 2005-2006 school calendar was developed by the Miami-Dade County Public Schools/United Teachers of Dade Calendar Ad Hoc Committee. The committee was composed of teachers, principals, district administrators, as well as representatives from all bargaining units and PTA/PTSA.

The criteria below were considered in developing the calendar:

- 240 days for students
- 257 days for teachers (240 days for students; 11 teacher planning days; six (6) legal holidays)
- Pre-school and post-school planning days, when possible
- Corresponding recess days, when possible.

The Elementary and Secondary School Calendar, 2005-2006, was used by the Calendar Ad Hoc Committee as a guide to develop the Juvenile Justice Education Extended School Year Calendar.

Attached are the Notice of Intended Action and the rule proposed for amendment. Changes from the current rule are indicated by underscoring words to be added and ~~striking through~~ words to be deleted.

Authorization of the Board is requested for the Superintendent to initiate rulemaking proceedings in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act for the amendment of School Board Rule 6Gx13- 6A-1.023, Juvenile Justice Education Extended School Year Calendar, 2004-2005. The amendment proposes an opening of school for students enrolled in Juvenile Justice Education centers on Monday, August 15, 2005.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to initiate rulemaking proceedings in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act to amend School Board Rule 6Gx13- 6A-1.023, Juvenile Justice Education Extended School Year Calendar, 2004-2005.

NOTICE OF INTENDED ACTION

THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, announced on February 16, 2005, its intention to amend Board Rule 6Gx13- 6A-1.023, Juvenile Justice Education Extended School Year Calendar, 2004-2005, at its meeting of April 13, 2005.

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: To establish the school calendar for the Juvenile Justice Education centers for the 2005-2006 school year.

SUMMARY: Establishes the school calendar for the 2005-2006 school year for the Juvenile Justice Education centers, designating days when students and teachers are and are not in school, beginning and ending dates of grading periods, and holidays for students and employees.
