The Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) under the No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Act of 2001, Title I, School Improvement and Title V, Part A has authorized funding to hire mathematics and reading coaches in public schools with accountability grades of F. The coaches hired under the auspices of these grants will implement effective mathematics and reading programs. Schools currently funded for reading coaches by the FLDOE were not eligible to apply for additional funds for reading coaches. The District submitted applications for all eligible schools in Miami-Dade County.

Authorization is requested to accept two grant awards from the FLDOE totaling \$1,170,000, to fund the Reading Coach and Mathematics Coach Program at selected schools for the grant period of October 20, 2004 through June 30, 2005. The grant award under Title I, School Improvement, is funded in the amount of \$845,000, and the grant award under Title V, Part A is funded in the amount of \$325,000.

As a member of the leadership team at the school, each coach will support the implementation of reading or mathematics programs leading to improvement in the respective academic content areas. The coaches will not have classroom teaching responsibilities; rather, they will coordinate reading and mathematics programs, analyze disaggregated student data, serve as a stable resource for professional development, and schedule weekly meetings with small groups of students and teachers. Furthermore, reading and mathematics coaches will coordinate their efforts to ensure that reading strategies are integrated into mathematics courses. The strategies will target those students who are not at the reading level necessary to comprehend the mathematics lessons. Reading strategies will be delivered during mathematics classes.

No matching funds are required as a condition to receive these grant funds. Grant funds in the amount of \$1,115,029 will be used for 12 mathematics coaches and six reading coaches, professional and technical services, travel, and materials. The indirect cost is \$54,971, for a total allocation of \$1,170,000.

Official notification of these grant awards was received on January 5, 2005, which is after the start of the grant period. Reimbursement of grant-related expenditures is authorized effective October 20, 2004.

**RECOMMENDED:** That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, authorize the Superintendent to:

- accept two grant awards from the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) for funding under the Reading Coach and Mathematics Coach Program at selected schools in the total amount of \$1,170,000 for the grant period of October 20, 2004 through June 30, 2005;
- extend this program as authorized through official notification from the granting agency in order to complete the goals of the program; and
- 3. direct Financial Operations to establish appropriations in the amounts approved or as amended by the granting agency; such appropriations to be reported periodically to the Board.
