This item is submitted for consideration by the School Board to amend Board Rule 6Gx13-6A-1.024, School Improvement Zone School Calendar, 2004-2005. The criteria below were considered in developing the calendar for the 2005-2006 school year:

- 187 days for K-12 students
- 206 days for K-12 teachers (187 school days for students, ten (10) planning days; three (3) professional development days, and six (6) legal holidays)
- Preschool and post school planning days, where possible
- Corresponding recess days, where possible

Attached are the Notice of Intended Action and the rule proposed for amendment. Changes from the current rule are indicated by <u>underscoring</u> words to be added and striking through words to be deleted.

Authorization of the Board is requested for the Superintendent to initiate rulemaking proceedings in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act for the amendment of School Board Rule 6Gx13-6A-1.024, School Improvement Zone School Calendar, 2004-2005. The amendment proposes a starting date for students in schools designated as School Improvement Zone schools on Monday, August 1, 2005.
