**SUBJECT: PROPOSED OPENING AND CLOSING TIMES FOR NON-SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT ZONE SITES AND SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT ZONE SITES: ELEMENTARY, K-8 CENTERS, MIDDLE, AND SENIOR HIGH SCHOOLS, FOR THE LAST THREE DAYS OF SCHOOL FOR NON-ZONE SITES – MAY 27, 31, AND JUNE 1, 2005, AND FOR THE LAST FIVE/SIX DAYS OF SCHOOL FOR ZONE SITES – JUNE 1, 2, 3, 6, 7, AND 8, 2005**

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**COMMITTEE: INSTRUCTIONAL EXCELLENCE & COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT**

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Pursuant to School Board Rule 6Gx13- 6A- 1.03 Instruction-Elementary and Secondary, the Superintendent of Schools is required to report changes in opening and closing hours of school to the Board in open session sixty (60) days prior to the effective date, except in unusual circumstances.

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On May 27, 31, and June 1, 2005, elementary schools and K-8 Centers will be dismissed at the conclusion of a five (5)-hour and 15-minute day; middle schools will be dismissed at the conclusion of a five (5)-hour and 30-minute day; and senior high schools will be dismissed at the conclusion of a four (4)-hour and 30-minute day. These times apply to non-School Improvement Zone sites. This schedule allows secondary schools to establish a minimum of two (2) examination periods on each day, with students being released at the conclusion of the second testing period.

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On June 2, 3, 6, 7, and 8, 2005, elementary schools and K-8 Centers will be dismissed at the conclusion of a six (6) hour and 15 minute day. On June 1, 2, 3, 6, 7, and 8, 2005, middle schools will be dismissed at the conclusion of a minimum six (6) hour and 40 minute day; and senior high schools will be dismissed at the conclusion of a five (5) hour and 30 minute day. This schedule allows secondary schools to establish a minimum of two (2) examination periods on each day.

This early dismissal is permissible under Section 228.041 (13) School Day, Florida Statutes.

Since there are only two days scheduled for post-school planning activities, the reduced school day for elementary and secondary schools provides additional time for teachers to prepare for the closing, such as grading examinations, posting and averaging grades, and reviewing

promotion requirements. Additionally, Zone schools are expected to facilitate parent conferences, student exhibitions/performances, transitions and other end-of-the-year activities.

**RECOMMENDED:**

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida:

1. approve for May 27, 31, and June 1, 2005, a reduction of the school day in non-School Improvement Zone sites:
  - elementary schools to five (5) hours and 15 minutes;
  - K-8 Centers to five (5) hours and 15 minutes;
  - middle schools to five (5) hours and 30 minutes;
  - senior high schools to four (4) hours and 30 minutes; and
2. approve for June 2, 3, 6, 7 and 8, 2005, a reduction of the school day in all Zone elementary schools and the K-8 Centers to six (6) hours and 15 minutes; and
3. approve for June 1, 2, 3, 6, 7 and 8, 2005, a reduction of the school day in all Zone middle schools to a minimum of six (6) hours and 40 minutes; and in all Zone senior high schools to five (5) hours and 30 minutes; and
4. authorize the Superintendent to make any special adjustments necessary due to unique circumstances in particular schools.

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
