"I come as a pilgrim, a pilgrim in the cause of justice and peace and human solidarity, striving to build up the one human family," said Pope John Paul II upon his arrival in Miami where he was greeted by thousands of people waving yellowand-white papal banners, in 1987.

Since elected to the Papacy in 1978, Pope John Paul II united persons of all faiths and worked endlessly defending human rights while leading the fight against oppression. Travelling to 125 countries, he spread his message and was credited with helping topple communism in eastern Europe by sparking what amounted to a peaceful revolution in his Polish homeland. To those who did not know how to get rid of communism he comforted them by saying "Do not be afraid."

As a spiritual leader and social reformer, John Paul seized the high moral ground in world affairs. Unafraid to articulate his vision of a better world, Pope John Paul led with passion and integrity and held himself to that vision. He was the embodiment of character, leadership, and morality. It is doubtful there has ever been a pope who has so successfully translated his strength, determination and faith into such widespread respect and goodwill. In a world of shifting trends and leaders of questionable virtue, John Paul II was a towering figure at the moral center of modern life.
