**SUBJECT: REQUEST AUTHORIZATION FOR STUDENT/TEACHER TO
TRAVEL OUT OF THE COUNTRY**

Authorization is requested for a student and a teacher to travel to Kigali, Rwanda, to participate in the African Sisters Schools Project, June 30 – July 10, 2005.

At the Board meeting of August 22, 2001, the School Board approved Agenda Item K-2 authorizing the Superintendent to determine the strategy for collaborating with the Foundation for Democracy in Africa (FDA) in an effort to establish a sister-school partnership and student exchange program. As a part of this development, the Foundation for Democracy in Africa is providing funding for a student and a teacher to travel to Kigali, Rwanda, to engage in an education exchange experience with the Fawe Girls School.

Last year, the School Board approved the out-of-country field trip to Rwanda for a student from Miami Carol City Senior High School and a teacher from Carol City Elementary School to participate in this same exchange program from October 3-10, 2004.
