The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, announced on February 16, 2005, its intention to amend School Board Rule 6Gx13- 6A-1.023, Juvenile Justice Education Extended School Year Calendar, for the 2005-2006 school year, at its meeting of April 13, 2005.

The Notice of Intended Action was published in the *Miami Daily Business Review* on February 22, 2005, posted in various places for public information, and mailed to various organizations representing persons affected by the amended rule and to individuals requesting notification.

The time to request a hearing or protest the adoption of this rule has elapsed.

In accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act, this amended rule is presented to The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, for adoption and authorization to file the rule in the official records of The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida.

Attached is the Notice of Intended Action and the amended rule. Changes from the current rule are indicated by underscoring words to be added and ~~striking through~~ words to be deleted.

RECOMMENDED: That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, adopt amended Board Rule 6Gx13- 6A-1.023, Juvenile Justice Education Extended School Year Calendar, 2005-2006, and authorize the Superintendent to file the rule with The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, to be effective August 15, 2005.

NOTICE OF INTENDED ACTION
