SUBJECT: AGREEMENT BETWEEN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY AND THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF WATER FACILITIES TO SERVICE THE CAROL CITY MIDDLE SCHOOL SITE MODULAR CLASSROOM ADDITION PROJECT A01009

COMMITTEE: FACILITIES AND CONSTRUCTION REFORM

In order to provide additional fire protection to the Carol City Middle School site, (Modular Classroom Addition), the Board must install and connect a water main extension and fire hydrant and other appurtenances to the existing Miami-Dade County (County) infrastructure (see location map).

The 14-acre school site is located at 3737 NW 188 Street. A proposed 8" water main will interconnect to an existing offsite County-owned 16" water main on NW 37 Avenue. One new hydrant will be installed. The approximate cost for the installation of these water facilities is \$15,000.

The agreement for the water facilities installation has been reviewed and recommended by the Office of School Facilities and the School Board Attorney's Office. Public utility facilities constructed on Board-owned property will be conveyed, with appropriate easements, to Miami-Dade County for future maintenance and operation.

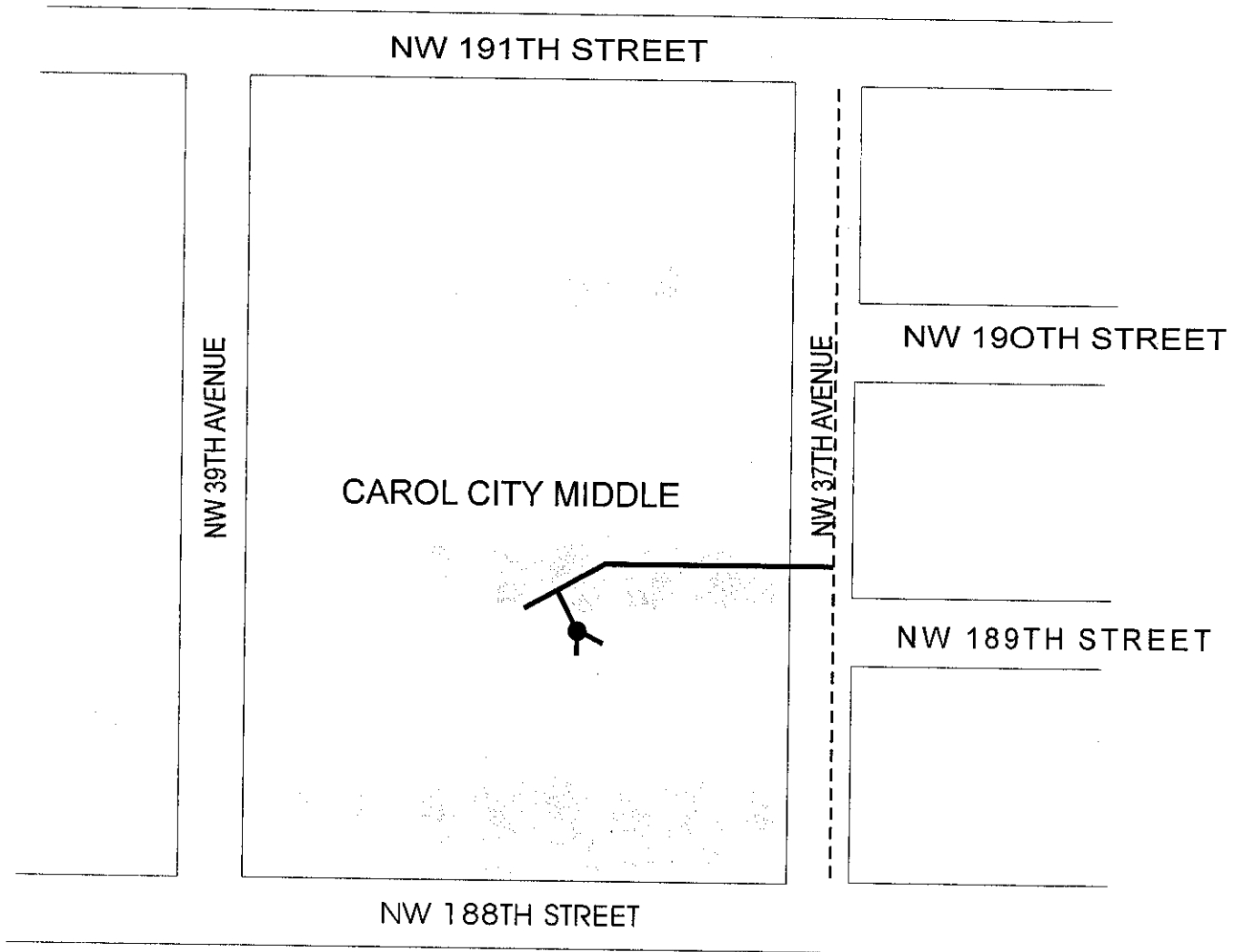

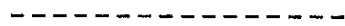
