**SUBJECT: ACCEPTANCE OF RESIGNATION - THE SCHOOL BOARD OF MIAMI-  
DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA v. SAM C. MILLER  
DOAH CASE NO. 05-1151**

By letter dated March 14, 2005, the Superintendent of Schools notified teacher Sam C. Miller that he would recommend at the regularly scheduled meeting of April 13, 2005, that the School Board take action to terminate the teacher's employment contract for failure to correct noted performance deficiencies during his 90-day calendar performance probation. The employee requested a hearing.

On April 1, 2005, the employee tendered his resignation from the Miami-Dade County Public Schools, effective April 12, 2005.

It is recommended that the resignation be accepted as achieving the objective sought by the School Board in this case. Acceptance of the resignation, previously forwarded under separate cover, will obviate the requirement for further legal actions by the School Board.

**RECOMMENDED:**

That The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida accept the resignation of Sam C. Miller, teacher, effective April 12, 2005, at the close of the workday.
